

## IT IS OK






Being friends can sometimes seem easy, but is it really so? How do you react when your friend wants something different? This is a quiet, clever picture book about being different but still friends. Sometimes we have to focus on what we have in common rather than what sets us apart.

In 2021, the artwork for *IT IS OK* has been selected for the Bologna Illustrators Exhibition, the Golden Pinwheel Young Illustrators Competition, and highly Commended in the Macmillan Prize.





**Ye Guo** is a Chinese illustrator, currently based in the UK. She graduated from Anglia Ruskin University with a major in children's books. Ye Guo always gravitates towards mixed-media techniques, including monoprint, collage, pencil, color pencil, gouache, and crayon. Her inspiration is from everyday life – to observe small emotions from her daily life, sketch them and make them into stories.





How do you play cards when you don't know how to play cards? Can you make it up? The gnu and the badger are going to find a way and they might even invite you to play with them.





## The Rainbow Baby




With this colorful firework of a picture book, Josefine Engström makes her debut. The story is told by a distinct child voice, who isn't hindered by adults' incapability of imagination.

Josefine Engström studied illustration in London. She ran the illustrator agency NU Agency for eight years, and has been both assistant professor and lecturer at the University of Arts, Crafts And Design in Sweden.

Everyone at preschool is playing in groups of two or three. Jiro is only one.

On a planet far away Yx is floating around, bored. Eating rocks. Watching the suns spin. But then she jumps into her friends' spaceship and lands in a strange galaxy where instead of floating she thumps down onto something green and soft. Yx meets a creature with two legs and ten fingers, a creature named Jiro. Jiro shows Yx his world.

When the other space horses return to their home planet, some preschool children and a teacher come along. But Jiro and Yx stay, they want to be together.

A subtle picture book in which we return to the preschool setting from Elisabet Ericson's earlier books. It centers around being a part of something or not, be it a group of friends or make-believe. In *The Space Horse* we meet Jiro who hasn't found his place. Until the day the space horse arrives!

**Elisabet Ericson** studied illustration and graphic design at the University of Arts, Crafts And Design in Stockholm. She made her picture book debut with *I Am Seven Animals* in 2018, and her book *Close Your Eyes!* was selected for the Bologna Illustrators Exhibition in 2021.










Atlas of Solitary Islands Etana editions, 2018

Francesca Scotti & Claudia Palmarucci





The Enchantment of Darkness marks her debut as a children's book author.

Claudia Palmarucci studied at the Arts Academy of Macerata where she now teaches. She was selected for the Illustr'arte 2011 and for the prestigious CJ Picture Book 2011. In 2020, her book about Marie Curie (text by Irène Cohen-Janca) won the Bologna Ragazzi Award in the category non-fiction.

# The Powder King's Window

In the attic of a house in the Lublin ghetto, the Jewish boy Henio has found his own secret kingdom. Henio shows this special place to his best friend, who is also the narrator of the story. The attic has magical roof windows: when the windows are open, the horrors of the war are seen; if closed, a different world is disclosed, perhaps even a peaceful one. One night, Henio runs to his friend, who is not Jewish, to convince him to run away together, but the friend is too afraid and decides to stay. In the morning, there is a round-up, but Henio has disappeared. His friend looks for him everywhere, even in the attic. There, on the window glass, he finds a child's fingerprints and a greeting.

Pierdomenico Baccalario has written a moving story to remove the dust from the history of the Lublin ghetto and imagine a different epilogue, also for Henio Zytomirski.

Pierdomenico Baccalario is a writer and journalist, his books have sold millions of copies worldwide and have been translated into over 30 languages.


Alice Barberini has studied art in Ravenna and fine art restoration in Florence and is since 2007 working as a book illustrator. Orecchio acerbo has published Ernest and Snow White written by Luca Tortolini (2022), In the Tube (2020), Hamelin (2017) and The Dog and the Moon (2015).

Henio Zytomirski (March 25, 1933–Nov 9, 1942) was born in Lublin, Poland, and died at the age of 9 at Majdanek concentration camp. Henio became an icon of the Holocaust, not only in Lublin but all over Poland. The "Letters to Henio" project has been held in Lublin on Holocaust Remembrance Day since 2005.









#### Mulle Mecks's Smallest Books

Freddy Fixer stands for curiosity, inventiveness, ingenuity and adventure. For him, there are no scraps, only old things that can be put to new use. When he isn't building or fixing, he is helping out his friends where he lives.

These two new board books are for the youngest readers, who get to join Freddy Fixer and his dog Buffa as they are going to bed, and wake up in the morning.

George Johansson is a journalist and writer. He has published numerous works of fiction and non-fiction for both children and adults. Together with Jens Ahlbom he has created the hugely popular books, computer games and films about Freddy Fixer.

Jens Ahlbom is one of Sweden's most famous illustrators of children's books. He is an art teacher and has illustrated more than 60 books. In 2003, he was awarded the prestigious Elsa Beskow Plague for his work. Part of the jury's motivation was: "An equal to Freddy Fixer when it comes to ingenuity and craftmanship."

We really could use some fresh air.




